Information on potential Volunteer Positions

Volunteer roles are positions within the Foundation that are unpaid and contain duties that are not being done by paid staff.

There are many roles that a volunteer can have within the Bateman Foundation. Below are examples of positions and responsibilities that could be available at any given time.

1. Docent Volunteer:

- A friendly face and source of information for our visitors, docents are responsible for interacting with the public, answering questions, and ensuring the safety of the artwork in the gallery.
- They may also be requested to help with simple administrative tasks (wrapping calendars, folding booklets, etc.), and minor clean-ups (sweeping small debris from the gallery floor, etc.).
- Docents are an extension of the front-line staff.
- Docents share their acquired knowledge of Robert Bateman - his life, art,

inspirations, and philosophy, with visitors

- Comfortable using technology
- Comfortable speaking with the public

2. Special Events Volunteer:

- An events volunteer would assist in facilitating after hour events.
- Special Events Volunteers are responsible for the safety of the artwork and the

gallery. Some clean-up duties are included (bussing dirty dishes, collecting

unwanted garbage, etc.).

- Ideally a rental support volunteer would be available for the whole event/venue rental

- Assist in crowd control, set up/take down, protecting artwork
- Events include private functions and exhibit openings
- Comfortable speaking with the public and have general knowledge about Robert

Bateman and other exhibits.

3. Outreach Volunteer:

- An operations volunteer's duties would be to help hand out information on The Bateman Foundation and Inner Harbour.
- They would assist in Bateman Foundation promotions by handing out pamphlets and other materials to specific downtown Victoria locations.
- In the summer, the volunteer mans the outdoor promotional bird cart and interacting with visitors, while showing them our monthly Newsletters, Memberships, and Public Programming, e.g. Sketch Club information
- Must be comfortable speaking with the public and sharing knowledge of The Bateman Foundation and programs.

4. Retail Volunteer:

- Retail volunteers help provide backup for internet order processing, wrapping packages and collecting merchandise ready for the Retail Manager to process.
- They may also occasionally assist on busy event days in the Gift Shop by helping staff to introduce customers to a wide variety of locally made artwork and Robert Bateman merchandise.
- Some retail experience preferred if working directly with customers

5. Public Programming Volunteer:

- Our public programming/education volunteers would help the program manager in preparation and execution of the gallery's education programs.
- Public programming Volunteers help the Program Manager and Learning Coordinator to deliver and prepare school and gallery educational programs.
- Must be comfortable interacting with youth and have interest in education, particularly related to art and/or nature.
- Assist the Program Manager with the preparation of school education programs and gallery education programs.

6. Gallery Maintenance Volunteer:

- Gallery maintenance volunteers would ideally be a handy person that assists staff in maintenance and in building/installing exhibits and displays
- Volunteer requires experience in painting, construction, and possibly electrical work (certificate required)

7. Gallery Tour Guide Volunteer:

- For people who would like to provide face-to-face tours of our gallery space (+/- 45 minutes long), with a focus on Robert Bateman and his works.
- The coordinator will provide Training and information.
- Great opportunities to converse, socialize, and share your passion for art.

8. Social Media Volunteer:

- Assists with the creation of social media content with our team, and spreading the virtual word about the Bateman Foundation and its many projects.
- Can be done off-site and in an online/virtual capacity.
- A great way to use your computer skills in support of the Foundation.

9. Nature Walk Volunteer:

- Volunteers to help out with our guided nature walks. Attending these walks to ensure a more interactive and attentive experience.
- Nature walks could include sketching sessions and interactions with younger, older, and many kinds of people.

10. Copywriter volunteer:

- Assists in writing compelling marketing and promotional materials for a wide variety of products and services within the realm of the foundation.
- Edit and proof work to ensure high editorial standards are met across all content outputs.
- Can be done off-site and in an online/virtual capacity.

11. Website developer volunteer:

- Assists in optimizing the website to ensure KPIs are tightly aligned with marketing objectives.
- Has experience with data analysis, SEO, CMS, and new initiatives to drive growth.
- Can be done off-site and in an online/virtual capacity.
- A great way to use your computer skills in support of the Foundation.
